



# TanenbaumCHAT Tuition Accessibility Program (TTAP)

We are excited to introduce a new initiative that continues to make tuition more affordable, so that families can give their children the gift of a TanenbaumCHAT education.

The TanenbaumCHAT Tuition Accessibility Program (TTAP) will start in the 2022-23 school year. TTAP will provide tiered tuition for enhanced financial accessibility and tuition predictability.

Qualification for TTAP will be determined through a quick and straightforward online process that will be confidential and limited in scope. We are developing an easy-to-use online calculator to allow families to confidentially estimate their tuition amount.
